NCC Education Global Examinations should be scheduled according to these principles:

- Global examinations will be scheduled in accordance with the dates and times published in the NCC Education Examination Dates document available to download from Connect web portal under section: *Activity Schedules and Examination Dates* or alternatively via the website: www.nccedu.com.
- A candidate may have two examinations in one day. Where candidates have more than one examination in a day, the total number of hours of examinations in any one day will not normally be more than four (i.e. if you have a 3-hour examination and 1-hour examination or two 2-hour examinations but not 2 x 3-hour examinations).
- Where candidates have an examination in the evening (i.e. finishing after 5.00pm), they will not have an examination before 9:00am the following morning.
- If candidates have two examinations on one day, the minimum period of time between examinations will be 90 minutes.
